- Applying organisational learning by investigating environmental incidents and communicating actions taken or required to prevent recurrence.
- Taking reasonable steps to:
 - preserve culture and heritage,
 - minimise disruption to local communities, and
 - preserve biodiversity and ecosystems.
- Setting performance targets annually which supports the objectives and targets of AIMS.
- Applying risk management principles in everything we do.
- Complying with applicable legal, other, and voluntary requirements.
- Monitoring, reviewing and reporting on the performance of AIMS to ensure that it remains suitable, effective and is continuously improving.

Under this Policy employees, contractors and suppliers are accountable for:

- Ensuring the application of this Policy.
- Adopting and complying with all AIMS policies, procedures and instructions.
- Reporting all incidents, near misses, or failures associated with environmental management and taking positive steps to resolve or escalate matters accordingly.
